

Ron Banker on Ride Safety

Well, did you try turning your head? If you caught the meeting you understand. If you missed it, then listen up! When cornering while riding your bike, give a conscious effort to turn your head and LOOK through the turn. It is called "visual directional control." You go where you look. How important is this? Very! Single vehicle crashes are often caused by the rider entering a curve over speed, then looking at the side of the road or some other fixed object. If they had just pressed more and kept looking through the turn to the exit and beyond, they would have cornered safely and avoided the mishap. Also try this, at a stop sign or light controlled intersection, TURN Your Head and face the way you are going to turn, while S. L. O. W. L. Y easing out the clutch. Your turns from a stop will improve and keep you from drifting wide or into oncoming traffic.

Ride Safe, and keep your knees in the breeze!
